City staff will be present while the test takes place. The public is encouraged to report any sightings of red dye in the waterway or the drainage system in the areas surrounding Park View Island. Please indicate the location, time of sighting and include a picture if possible and report it to the Control Room via email to publicworksoperations@miamibeachfl.gov or by calling 305-673-7625,



The red dye used for the testing is safe, nontoxic, biodegradable and certified to NSF International Standard 60, test poses no harm to human health or the environment.
