October 2007 Set as goals of the City of Miami Beach the adoption of policies and programs that strive to meet or exceed Kyoto Protocol targets for reducing global warming pollution.

January 2011

Approve and adopt the City of Miami Beach Sustainability Plan.

October 2015 Join the Compact of Mayors and pledge to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, track progress towards greenhouse gas reduction goals, and enhance the City's resiliency to climate change, in a manner that is consistent with and complementary to climate protection efforts at the national level.

May 2017 Support the Sierra Club's "Ready for 100%" campaign, which challenges cities across the United States to set a target of 100% clean, renewable energy.

October 2019 Declare a climate emergency, urging the state of Florida and the U.S. government to declare a climate emergency, requesting regional collaboration on an immediate just transition and emergency mobilization effort to restore a safe climate.

February 2021 Adopt the pledges of Under2 Coalition, and the United Nations Climate Change's "Climate Neutral Now "and "Race to Zero" campaigns, affirm the City's pledge to support greenhouse gas emissions reductions while planning for the challenges of climate change.

April 2021 Recognize the effects of climate change caused by human activity and approve the City's joint effort with the City of Miami, Florida, to establish a climate action goal to achieve net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050.
