1. FOCUS ON THE MOST COMMON RECYCLABLES

2. KEEP THESE ITEMS OUT OF YOUR RECYCLING CART:

- Yard Waste
- Pizza boxes and food containers
- Batteries
- Plastic bags
- Styrofoam
- Home chemicals
- Electronic waste



3. DO NOT OVERSTUFF YOUR CART

Break down your cardboard, crush cans and bottles to have more space! Be sure the lid to your cart closes.

Overflowing carts or carts with materials on the outside will NOT be picked up!



4. PLACE YOUR CART OUT ON THE CURB THE RIGHT WAY!

Roll your cart out to the curb prior to 7 a.m. on Wednesdays. Place your recycling cart within 3' of the street and at least 5' away from mailboxes, parked cars, or other obstacles (light poles, cable and/or other wires).

The wheels must face your home; after collection, return your cart to its storage place.
